

GRANTHAM COLLEGE LICENSED AREAS, SALE OF ALCOHOL POLICY

In accordance with new mandatory conditions regarding the changes to the 2003 Licensing Act, the following procedure must be strictly adhered to by all persons authorised to sell alcohol on behalf of Grantham College.

The “responsible person” shall ensure that :- individuals that appear to be under the age of 21 years are asked to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark showing them to be over 18 years of age.

In the case of those adults purchasing beer wine or cider for persons over 16 while taking a table meal, identification as described above will be required , showing them to be over 16 years of age, before the alcohol is served.

It should be noted that it is an offence to serve, deliver *or allow consumption* of alcohol to a person of less than 18 years of age.

It should be noted that it is an offence to purchase or attempt to purchase alcohol for a person of less than 18 years of age*.

Grantham College operates all licensed areas in accordance with the 2003 Licensing Act and the “challenge 21 initiative”.

*The exception being those persons of 16 or 17 taking a table meal provided that an adult purchases the drink (beer, wine or cider) and accompanies the 16/17 year olds during the meal.
