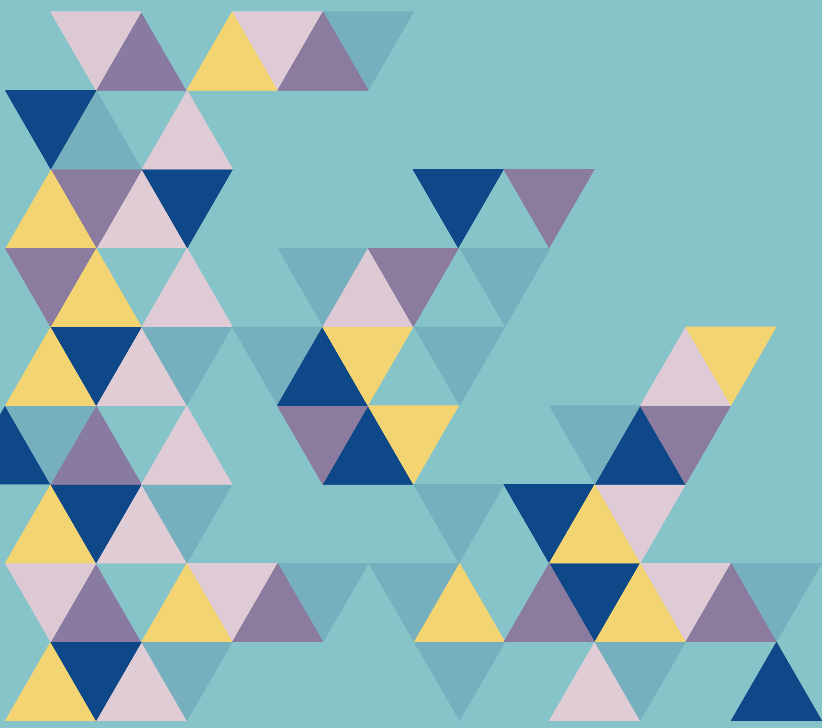


PART-TIME COURSE GUIDE

Course Fee Payment Options

A lot of the time cost is a big barrier for adults looking to return to learning. At Grantham College, we're committed to widening access to education and there are a variety of options open to you which can make study more affordable.

Take a free course with us

A lot of Grantham College courses for adults are totally free, although in each case certain criteria will apply. See below for to check that you are eligible.

Pay in instalments

If the course fee is over £250, you are entitled to pay it in instalments to help spread the cost.

1 year courses or courses where fees are payable on an annual basis

- Total fees: £250 - £499 = up to 4 instalments based upon the length of the course.
First instalment payable on enrolment.
Subsequent payments are taken monthly.
- Or Tuition fees: £500+ = up to 7 instalments based upon the length of the course.
First instalment payable on enrolment.
Subsequent payments are taken monthly.

Pay for training with a Level 3 Advanced Learner Loan

If you're aged 19 or over and are thinking about further education or training in England, you might qualify for an Advanced Learner Loan. Most learners aged 19 and over, studying at Level 3 and above, will qualify for these new loans from the UK government.

It's easy to apply for and you won't have to pay anything back until your income is over a certain amount

The loan is to pay course fees. The minimum amount you can get is £300 and it's paid directly to the college or course provider. If you prefer, you can pay part of the course fee yourself and use a loan to pay the remainder.

FREE Courses for Adult Learners

To be eligible, you must meet the criteria below:

- Are you 19+ (as of the 1st September 2020)?
- Are you earning less than £17004.00 annual gross salary?
- Are you an EEA or UK citizen and have been a resident in the EEA or UK for the previous 3 years or have full right of abode in the UK?

You will be asked to provide evidence of your income to qualify for our free courses. Not applicable to students currently studying on an apprenticeship.
