Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are a great way to bring a new member of staff into your business – or upskill an existing member - with the knowledge and competencies they need to help your business thrive. Apprentices generally work full-time and this work is supplemented with 6 hours of training per week, mainly delivered by expert skill trainers from Grantham College. They range in length from 1 year to a number of years, depending on the area and level.

New Engineering Equipment



Brand-new industry standard Engineering workshops at Grantham College.

We are very pleased to say that we have been successful in the Office for Students capital bid and have been awarded just over £1m to buy brand-new kit for, and refurbish, our mechanical, hydraulics, and automotive engineering workshops. Working closely with local Engineering employers, we have sourced and purchased the cutting-edge specialist equipment used in industry to train our students ready for the 21st century workplace.

Our mechanical kit list includes new lathes, workbenches, vices, shadow boards, tooling and VR welding systems. Our manufacturing, maintenance and hydraulics kit list includes CMM measuring, CNC machining, CNC lathe, control simulator, conveyor machine, and hydraulics training systems. The OfS-published statement about our project is below. The new facilities opened in September 2023.

The project is to refurbish and equip a mechanical, manufacturing and hydraulics engineering workshop space to contemporary industry standard. It mirrors the college's strategic plan by expanding curriculum development in those areas most directly linked to employability. The funding will enable the college to outfit an Engineering Innovation Centre with cutting-edge mechanical, computer numerical control (CNC) manufacturing, maintenance, and hydraulics engineering equipment, and run a new suite of higher education short courses in high demand occupational areas. It gives the college the means to train and develop a more robust future workforce in areas where demand is greatest from employers, both currently and in projected skills gaps.

Tools explored may include for example the use of pivot tables, conditional formatting and a range of formulae. Examples of outcomes may include quicker and improved data analysis, reporting and presentation and more efficient data.

We're excited to announce that we will be able to provide ILM training (Level 3 Certificate or Diploma in Leadership and Management) from January. An ILM Award (qualification) is one of the most popular leadership and management qualifications, with 70,000 managers registering to study a qualification each year. This can be delivered using a blended approach, with face-to-face sessions plus an e-portfolio, and we can provide a bespoke course with a minimum of 6 participants.

Professional Communication Skills (6-hour interactive workshop)

- Making a good first impression on clients verbally and in writing
- Barriers to good communication
- Writing clear and effective emails
- Telephone manner
- Overcoming communicative obstacles and challenges with clients (and colleagues)
- Handling and defusing difficult interaction (verbal or written)
- The importance of demonstrating empathy and building trust – and how to do it

Stress Management (6-hour interactive workshop):

- Awareness of the symptoms of stress, the stress cycle and burnout.
- Tools and coping mechanisms to alleviate stress in the short term (e.g. mindfulness techniques, boundary-setting with colleagues, appropriate CBT tools).

- Communication advice for managers and staff on having a conversation about stress/ burnout that's productive for both parties.

Resilience Training (6-hour interactive workshop)

Resilience is the capacity to withstand and recover from obstacles, challenges and setbacks. What comes as a surprise to most people is that resilience CAN be learnt, in the way that any skill can be learnt and developed. The reason why it is so important for employers to consider resilience training for their staff is because:

- Resilience correlates to performance
 a happier, solution- & opportunityfocussed environment.
- Low resilience leads to more days off sick due to stress, overwhelm and burnout.
- Higher resilience = more positive staff morale and collaborative team spirit.
- Resilience training is guiding people to build the tools to help themselves – your staff will appreciate the investment in their wellbeing.
- Increased focus, productivity, creativity and motivation.

A sample of content includes:

- Understanding of resilience, what it looks like (and what a lack of resilience looks like), and the connection between emotional wellness and resilience.
- Factors affecting our resilience levels.
- Awareness of the impact of emotional responses and thinking patterns, thoughts about the locus of control.
- Practical ways to build resilience (incl. goal-setting, avoiding unhelpful thinking traps, identifying icebergs, applying perspective etc.)
- Workplace resilience how to be more resilient in the context of work.
- What managers can do to encourage and support a resilient mindset in staff and engender resilience as a business.
- Further resources to explore after the session.

New esignup online platform

Making the enrolment process easier with our new esignup online platform.

You'll be aware that from September 2023 we started using an online platform called esignup to collect the information and create the documentation required to sign up your apprentices. Then the documentation is emailed to you and your apprentice using one link, for documents to be read and signed electronically online.

It's fair to say we did have a few teething issues – and we have appreciated your patience with us while we learnt how to use this new platform. Now the platform is working very well and we are confident it is an improvement on our processes and much better in terms of the employer (and apprentice) experience.

How has this improved the process for you?

- More convenient you can sign online at a time that suits you.
- Training plan and weekly/monthly content detailed clearly.
- All documents can be downloaded and saved as one report for your records.
- Quick it takes minutes to check and sign the documents.

Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIPs)

Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIPs) are a key part of achieving the aim set out in the government's Skills for Jobs White Paper, which looked to put employers more firmly at the heart of the skills system. Employers, training providers and other stakeholders were involved in the LSIP consultation, led by the FSB, which sought to fully understand barriers and opportunities and transform local skills provision with employers' needs at the very heart of the system.

Grantham College has been fully involved in this process and we welcome this integrated approach and closer collaboration between stakeholders. Our Accountability Statement, published in response to the LSIP for Greater Lincolnshire and Rutland, details what we are doing to ensure businesses have the talent and skills required to thrive. Actions include:

- Expanding the range of Skills Bootcamps in digital skills and green technologies.
- Providing bespoke ILM Leadership and Management training opportunities for businesses.
- Investing in new facilities for Engineering and Manufacturing, among other areas.
- Delivering training for the Lead Adult Care Worker and Healthcare Support Worker apprenticeships.
