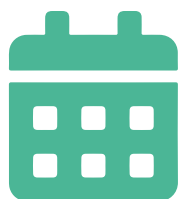

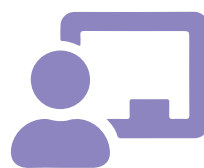

Free Courses for Adults

It can be difficult to get back into education. One thing people find hard is paying for courses. We have a lot of courses with no course fees. Take a look below.

Take a free course with us

A lot of our online learning, leisure and community courses for adults are totally free.

Anyone under 19 who applies for a CL course is required to pay £5 an hour. Some courses may incur a small charge for materials.

Level 2 courses for people earning up to £22,308

You can choose to study a wide range of full and part-time courses without having to pay any tuition fees. To be eligible for free adult courses you must:

- be 19 or older; and
- unemployed and currently seeking work
- or, on a low income of up to £22,308 per annum (you will need to provide wage slips or your last self-assessment form to evidence this), and
- want to study a Pre-Entry, Entry, Level 1 or Level 2 course.

Many courses are also free for people in receipt of certain benefits, including Universal Credit and Working Tax Credit.

Don't be put off by the cost of study, many of our students study for free. Eligibility depends on your individual circumstances and the course you have chosen to study.

Pay for training with a Level 3 Advanced Learner Loan

Advanced Learning Loan to help with college fees on applicable course.

Students won't have to pay anything back until the end of their course and are earning £27,295 per year. Household income isn't taken into account and there's no credit check.

Eligibility is dependent on course, nationality, and age to meet the ESFA funding eligibility criteria.

Pay in instalments

If the course fee is over £250, you are entitled to pay it in instalments to help spread the cost.

This is subject to the length of the course as any instalments need to be paid prior to the course end date. 1 year courses or courses where fees are payable on an annual basis

Total fees: £250 - £499 = up to 4 instalments based upon the length of the course. First instalment payable on enrolment. Subsequent payments are taken monthly.

Or Tuition fees: £500+ = up to 7 instalments based upon the length of the course. First instalment payable on enrolment. Subsequent payments are taken monthly

Access to Higher Education

Access courses are a fast-track route to degree-level study and are specifically designed for adults aged 19+ returning to education. They are the most widely recognised one year pre-university courses in the UK and have a very strong standing with all universities since they incorporate study skills, as well as subject and work specific theory for careers in many areas.

The majority of students apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to pay their tuition fees; this loan is waived on completion of an undergraduate degree for those who have obtained an Access to HE Diploma.

You are not required to pay any tuition fees up front for any of the Access to HE courses.
